

Food Pantry History

The Fayette County Food Pantry started as a mission project of the Fayette County Ministerial Association and was organized 26 years ago. It was started because there was a need in the community to provide emergency food.

The First Presbyterian Church basement houses the Fayette County Food Pantry, a location that was initially volunteered by Dr. Darrell Holmes.

In the early years of the Food Pantry, Fifth/Third Bank coordinated a yearly food drive, "Operation Feed", that supplied a major portion of the food needed.

Currently fundraising events sponsored by individuals, churches, schools, businesses, and service organizations fund the pantry. We are solely supported by these donations. One hundred percent of all donations go toward the purchase of food. The food pantry is staffed by volunteers who are passionate about helping those in need in our area

The Fayette County Food Pantry has undergone many changes in order to better serve the needs of Fayette County. We care about the community and appreciate the support we receive.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is my contribution to the food pantry tax deductible?

Yes, but you must make your check payable to the First Presbyterian Church and put "Food Pantry" in the memo. A receipt for your contribution will be given if requested.

How can I help someone in need?

A referral from one of the following agencies listed at the left is necessary. This referral form along with their identification can then be brought to the pantry for food.

How many times can a family get help in one year?

The Fayette County Food Pantry has been set up as an emergency food bank. A family can receive help every two months or six times yearly.

When can I come to the Fayette County Food Pantry?

- Have a grocery cart display set up in your business.
- Ask your friends, families, and neighbors to donate.
