

This program offers housing and support services to give veterans a stable base to find or hold a job, continue their recovery and, ultimately, return to independent living.

program requirements:

SERVED in active military, naval, air service, Merchant Marines or was activated by Presidential order and served in another state or country while in the National Guard or Reserves

GROSS ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME less than 50% of area median income for household size

LITERALLY HOMELESS (meaning living in a place not meant for human habitation, an emergency shelter, transitional housing, or hospital or other institution when prior to admission was in emergency shelter or a place not fit for human habitation) OR permanently housed but imminently at-risk of literal homelessness

NO OTHER RESOURCES or social supports

how the program works

Those who are homeless first receive assistance to find suitable housing. Then case managers work with the family to provide needed temporary financial assistance, linkage with community resources and VA benefits and a plan to improve housing stability.
