
Q3 What is your gender?






Q5 What is your ethnicity?



Q16 Do you believe the following issues exist in our community? Check all that apply.






Q17 If there was a time in the past year that you or anyone in your family needed medical care but could not get it, what were the reasons you did not get care? Check all that apply.




