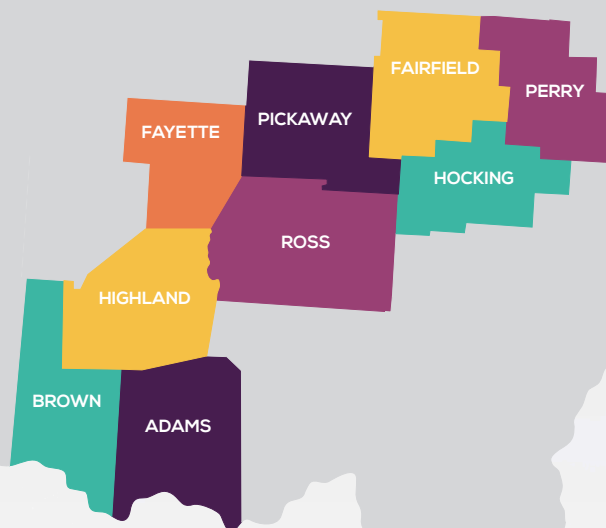

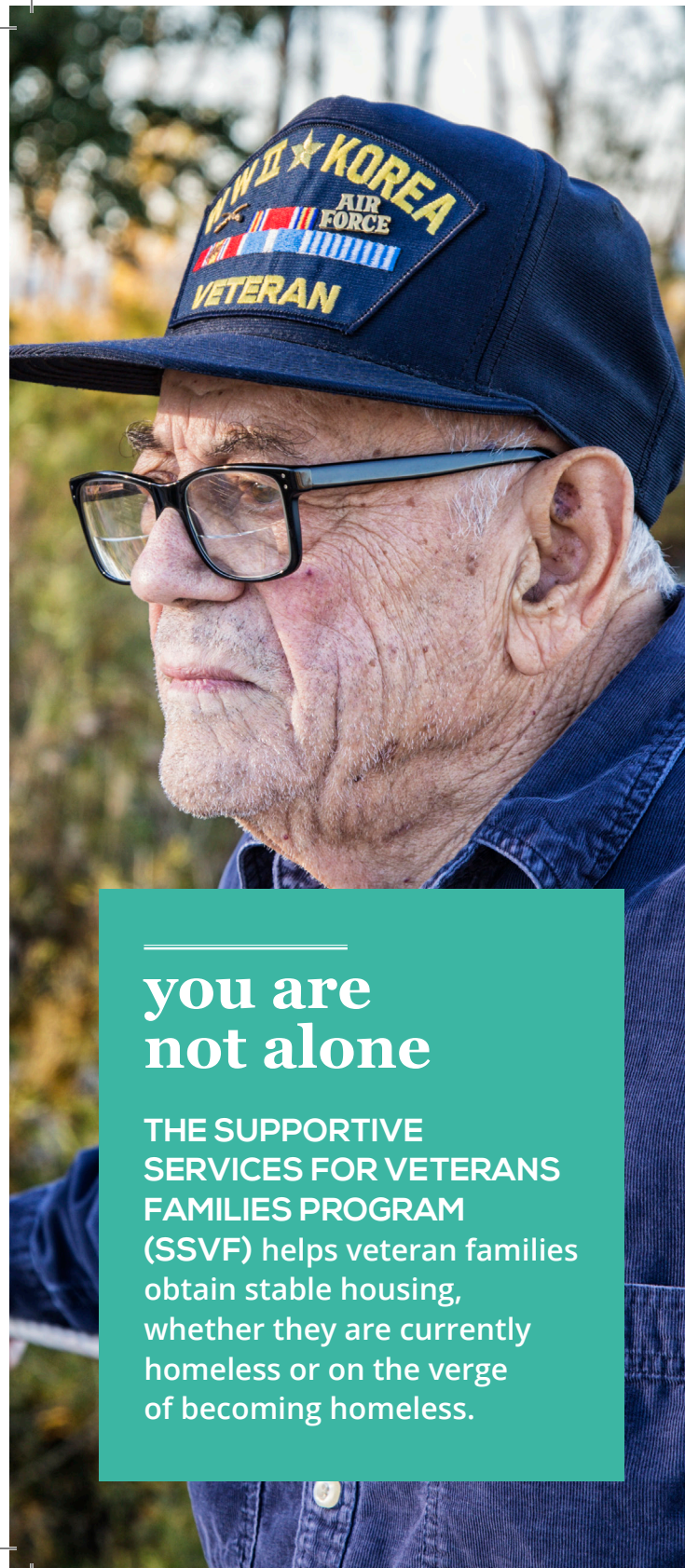

This program offers housing and support services to give veterans a stable base to find or hold a job, continue their recovery and, ultimately, return to independent living.

program requirements:

SERVED in active duty military, naval or air service (Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Marine Corps and Space Force). Reserves are eligible if served in active-duty, active-duty training or have a service-connected disability. National Guard is only eligible if there is federal active-duty service (serving under Title 10) or have a service-connected disability

GROSS ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME less than 80% of area median income for household size

LITERALLY HOMELESS (meaning living in a place not meant for human habitation, an emergency shelter, transitional housing, or hospital or other institution when prior to admission was in emergency shelter or a place not fit for human habitation) OR permanently housed but imminently at-risk of literal homelessness

NO OTHER RESOURCES or social supports

how the program works

Those who are homeless first receive assistance to find suitable housing. Then case managers work with the family to provide needed temporary financial assistance, linkage with community resources and VA benefits and a plan to improve housing stability.
